1 Service order

UCAR1025 LLC dba UCARDEALER (Dealer) will provide the limited auction inspection and report described in this agreement for the vehicles identified in the schedule. This agreement purchases an inspection service only. It does not reserve a vehicle, guarantee auction availability, authorize a bid, or require the Client to buy a vehicle.

The order begins when Dealer confirms the VIN list, quantity, unit price, total fee, access and scheduling in writing and both parties accept this agreement. No payment is collected merely by submitting the website request. No substitute vehicle or additional paid service is authorized without the Client's written approval.

2 Inspection fees and cancellation

For an order of 1 to 3 vehicles, the inspection fee is \$50 per vehicle. For an order of 4 or more vehicles, the fee is \$40 per vehicle for every vehicle in that order. Each vehicle must be identified by VIN in the attached schedule or a written supplement accepted by both parties.

The initially confirmed VIN list and quantity fix the unit price for the order. Client changes before confirmation require a recalculated quote and the Client's acceptance. Later additions or other Client-requested changes require a written amendment stating the affected VINs and agreed price. No unused inspection balance expires automatically.

The fee for a completed inspection and delivered report is earned whether the Client declines the vehicle, no bid is placed, or the auction is not won. It is nonrefundable after that service is completed, except where applicable law requires a refund or Dealer fails to perform the agreed service. Prepaid amounts allocated to inspections not performed are refundable; no automatic forfeiture or cancellation penalty applies. If the order is cancelled during work, Dealer may charge only for work and third-party costs separately approved in writing, without exceeding the allocated fee.

If a vehicle is withdrawn, access is denied, or Dealer or the auction cannot provide the agreed inspection, the Client may choose an approved replacement or refund of the unperformed portion at the confirmed unit price. This does not increase the price of the remaining inspections. Dealer will account for completed services and refund the remaining prepaid balance within 10 business days after cancellation, unless law requires an earlier refund. Inspection fees are separate from the \$500 per-vehicle completed-purchase fee in Section 7.

Inspection scope and report

3 Inspection and report

For each vehicle, Dealer will provide dated photographs and video showing the accessible exterior and interior, visible damage and defects, and a written opinion of the observed condition and apparent repair or maintenance needs. The inspection includes accessible fluid levels and visible condition, visible signs of active leaks, and an underbody review from safely accessible areas.

A short, low-speed driving check and electronic fault-code scan may be performed only if the auction permits them, access and equipment are available, and conditions are reasonably safe. Any diagnostic service requiring professional registration or authorization will be performed only by an appropriately registered or authorized provider. The report will identify the provider and the checks completed.

The fee includes obtaining and reviewing an available CARFAX vehicle-history report and reviewing available title information, auction announcements and documents. Dealer will identify the source and report date. If a promised history report or material access is unavailable, Dealer will notify the Client and agree in writing on any reduced scope or refund before proceeding on that basis.

4 Limits of the inspection

The inspection covers only what can reasonably be observed at that time without disassembly. It does not include a lift inspection unless access is available, a highway or extended road test, compression or leak-down testing, internal engine or transmission examination, a complete electrical diagnosis, battery-capacity testing, or a state safety or emissions certification.

Concealed, intermittent and future defects may remain undetected, including internal damage, hidden corrosion, prior repairs, water damage, disabled warning systems and conditions masked by recent servicing or code clearing. A code-free scan does not prove mechanical health or emissions readiness. Photographs and video do not show every area or defect.

Auction access, weather, lighting, time, keys, starting condition and third-party restrictions may limit the work. The report will state checks not performed and material limitations. An unchecked or inaccessible item is not represented as satisfactory. A short low-speed movement is not a full road test.

5 Opinion and client decision

The report is a limited assessment, not a warranty, certification of quality, promise of roadworthiness, or prediction of reliability, repair cost or remaining useful life. Dealer will perform the agreed services with reasonable care and accurately describe its observations. The Client may decline the vehicle after reviewing the report or request separately authorized specialist inspection where available.

The Client understands that a used auction vehicle may require substantial repairs and accepts the ordinary uncertainty of conditions outside the agreed inspection scope, subject to all rights preserved in Section 9. This agreement does not release Dealer from failure to perform agreed services, fraud, misrepresentation, willful misconduct, gross negligence, or any responsibility that cannot lawfully be waived.

6 History and documents

Third-party histories and auction statements may contain omissions or delays. Dealer will disclose material issues known to it and will not treat a clean history report as proof of an accident-free or defect-free vehicle. No guarantee of title availability, registration timing or completeness of third-party records is made. Dealer remains responsible for legally required title, history and other disclosures, including an NMVTIS report where required.

Purchase process and acceptance

7 Separate purchase authorization

Any purchase involves Dealer's auction acquisition followed by a separately documented retail sale to the Client. This inspection agreement creates no autobroker arrangement and does not replace the retail sale documents, Buyers Guide, title documents or required disclosures.

A \$500 completed-purchase fee applies to each vehicle successfully acquired at auction and sold to the Client. It is earned only when that vehicle's auction acquisition and retail sale are completed, subject to applicable cancellation and refund rights. No separate unsuccessful-bid fee applies. Auction price, auction fees, taxes, registration, title and separately approved services are additional.

Before bidding, Dealer will provide the report and itemized price schedule. The Client must sign a separate authorization for each VIN, sale date, maximum auction bid and maximum total amount. Neither cap may be exceeded without new written authorization. If costs would exceed the total cap, Dealer must lower the bid, obtain new approval, or not bid. Seller acceptance and delivery are not guaranteed.

8 Additional costs and delivery

Transport, detailing, preparation, repairs, maintenance and optional products require a written itemized price and Client approval. Required smog, safety, title and registration compliance remains Dealer's responsibility as applicable law requires. Registration and delivery dates are not guaranteed unless separately agreed in writing.

The purchase authorization must state payment deadlines, payment method, delivery arrangements and approved storage or transport charges. No unspecified penalty, automatic deposit forfeiture or open-ended expense authorization applies. Auction cancellation, title failure and lawful retail cancellation remain subject to the purchase documents and law.

9 Consumer rights

This inspection agreement creates no vehicle warranty. Any warranty or lawful AS IS sale terms must be consistent in the sale documents and Buyers Guide. Statutory warranties, disclosures, registration and emissions duties, cancellation rights, refund remedies and other nonwaivable protections remain effective.

Required sale documents will provide applicable California cancellation rights, including CARS Act rights operative October 1, 2026. Auction acquisition by Dealer does not itself exempt a later retail sale. Mandatory refund rights prevail over this agreement's fee provisions.

10 Acceptance and records

This agreement, vehicle schedule and written amendments accepted by both parties define the inspection order. Purchase requires separate signed documents. California law applies without restricting nonwaivable remedies or lawful choice of forum. If one provision is unenforceable, the remaining lawful provisions continue.

The Client may request paper copies and signatures. If electronic signing is chosen, the signer intends to authenticate this agreement; each party receives the accepted terms and completed order. Contact details may be used for this service. Acceptance is not consent to unrelated marketing.

Both parties accept the inspection terms and vehicle schedule. The Client acknowledges the limited scope and fees. These signatures do not authorize bidding.
